#### From Guidance

On Thursday November 7<sup>th</sup> - we hosted Grade 8 Night.

On Monday November  $19^{th}$  - Midterm Report cards were sent digitally to student emails. The Academic Awards Night is tomorrow November  $21^{st}$ . Students received invitations for the event.

Grade 12 College and University Applications are well underway.

Cooperative Education Department - Coop program is quite large this year particularly with SHSM students who are required to take coop as part of the program.
