COURSE SELECTION REMINDERS

GOING INTO GRADE 10

- Choose 8 courses in your high school planner
- Select History CHC2D or CHC2P- this is compulsory
- Select Civics and Careers CIVCAR-this is compulsory
- If you plan on taking a course in Summer School, leave that course off your selection and choose another elective in its place

GOING INTO GRADE 11

- Choose 8 Courses in your high school planner
- Choose English, Religion & Math these are compulsory
- Choose the English that matches your religion; ENG3U matches with HRT3MU, ENG3C matches with HRT3MC
- If you plan on taking a course in Summer School, leave that course off your selection and choose another elective in its place
- Ensure you have selected the prerequisites for courses you may want to take in grade 12. For example if you want grade 12 Physics, you must take grade 11 Physics

GOING INTO GRADE 12

- Choose 8 Courses in your high school planner
- Choose English; Note- Writer's Craft EWC4U does not count as your English Credit for grade 12; it is an elective
- Choose Religion HRE4M or Philosophy HZT4U to meet the Religion requirement
- Choose the English that matches your religion; ENG4U matches with HRE4MU, ENG4C matches with HRE4MC
- If you plan on apply to a University degree program, you will need to have 6 grade 12 U
 or M level courses in your course planner
- You can only take one grade 12 IDC4U course. (One of IDC4UA, IDC4UB or IDC4UM)
- Make sure you have 30 credits in your planner for graduation
- If you plan on taking a course in Summer School, leave that course off your selection and choose another elective in its place
