- X Regulated trades work
- X Factory work (if under 15)
- X Court-appointed work
- X Work for commercial business

- **X** Duplication for credit in other courses
- X Class or course requirements
- X Provide direct financial benefit or gain to the student or to the student's immediate family
- X Work that does not comply with or contradict Catholic teachings or the policies of the DPCDSB or Ministry of Education
- X Involves "designated substances" under the Occupational Health and Safety Act
