*A maximum of 3 credits in English as a second language (ESD or English literacy development (ELD) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit samed for a Grade 12 compulsory English course. **In groups 1, 2, and 3, a maximum of 2 credits in French as a second language can count as compulsory credits, one from group 1 and one from either group 2 or group 3. ***M maximum of 2 credits in cooperative education can count as compulsory credits. †The 12 optional credits may include up to 4 credits earned through approved dual credit courses.



Do I need a PIN



No - Create your profile and begin selecting program choices

YES - Use your PIN to help create a unique sign-in for your profile and then select program choices

How much does it cost to apply





\$110 for 5 choices

No more than 3 programs at any one college



\$150 for 3 choices

Additional choices for \$50 each

No more than 3 programs at any one university

Do I have to rank my choices





No



It does not typically matter how you number your program choices on your application. A university must make it clear in its own policy information if there are exceptions. Consult the program information page of each of your choices to see if ranking of choices is a factor.

What grades are considered before colleges and universities make an offer ?



Midterm and final grades from semester one and midterm grades from semester two will be considered for offers.

Do colleges and universities consider my grade 11 marks when making their decision

What are the deadlines for applications





February 1, 2023

We recommend applying by December 20, 2022 to avoid delays in processing



January 12, 2023

You do not send them.

All grades are sent by the Guidance department.


